**SEC. 4271. REPEAL OF EXPANSION OF INFORMATION RE-  
PORTING REQUIREMENTS.**

Section 9006 of the Patient Protection and Afford-  
able Care Act, and the amendments made thereby, are

1 hereby repealed; and the Internal Revenue Code of 1986  
2 shall be applied as if such section, and amendments, had  
3 never been enacted.

4 **SEC. 4272. EXPANSION OF AFFORDABILITY EXCEPTION TO**  
5 **INDIVIDUAL MANDATE.**

6 Section 5000A(e)(1)(A) of the Internal Revenue Code  
7 of 1986 is amended by striking “8 percent” and inserting  
8 “5 percent”.

9 **SEC. 4273. USE OF PREVENTION AND PUBLIC HEALTH**  
10 **FUND.**

11 (a) **USE OF FUNDS AS OFFSET THROUGH FISCAL**  
12 **YEAR 2017.**—Section 4002(b) of the Patient Protection  
13 and Affordable Care Act is amended by striking “appro-  
14 priated—” and all that follows and inserting “appro-  
15 priated, for fiscal year 2018, and each fiscal year there-  
16 after, \$2,000,000,000”.

17 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
18 this section shall take effect as if included in the enact-  
19 ment of section 4002 of the Patient Protection and Af-  
20 fordable Care Act.

21 **SEC. 4274. TIME FOR PAYMENT OF CORPORATE ESTIMATED**  
22 **TAXES.**

23 The percentage under paragraph (2) of section 561  
24 of the Hiring Incentives to Restore Employment Act in

- 1 effect on the date of the enactment of this Act is increased
- 2 by 4.25 percentage points.
